Can I access Salesforce+ on streaming devices?

You can access Salesforce+ from anywhere at <u>salesforce.com/plus</u>. No apps or streaming devices needed.

How do I sign up for Salesforce+?

Signing up for Salesforce+ is free and easy. To sign up, head over to <u>salesforce.com/plus/dreamforce</u> and click "Sign Up to Watch Live." From there you'll be prompted to sign up or log in to your Trailblazer.me profile. Once you've completed that, you'll fill out a few additional details so we can personalize your experience, and then you're on your way to unlimited access to all of the content on Salesforce+.

What is Trailblazer ID?

Your Trailblazer ID (TBID) gives you access to a unified profile across the Salesforce ecosystem tailored for you as an individual. Also known as Trailblazer.me, with your Trailblazer ID you can manage your settings and access multiple Salesforce-related sites with one login. To sign up for

Salesforce+, every individual must use or create a Trailblazer ID.

What are Salesforce Originals?

Salesforce Originals are episodic programs produced in-house by Salesforce Studios.

The current lineup consists of:

What is Dreamforce?

Dreamforce is a global family reunion for all of our stakeholders – our community, our customers, our partners, and our employees – where we share innovation, customer success stories, and thought leadership. Dreamforce is streaming live on the all-new Salesforce+, where we enable millions of Trailblazers around the world to safely gather together to get inspired and get connected with each other. Join us for three days of learning, having fun, and giving back.

When and where will Dreamforce take place?

Dreamforce will stream live September 21–23, 2021, exclusively on the new Salesforce+ for free to everyone from anywhere.

How do I watch Dreamforce?

You can experience Dreamforce streaming live on Salesforce+, where our best original programming and broadcast experiences are available for free.

Instructions for joining the event if you've already signed up for Salesforce+:

- We recommend you log in a few minutes before the event begins
- To join, head to Dreamforce on Salesforce+, hover over "Login," and click "Trailblazer.me"
- Log in to the Trailblazer.me profile you created at sign-up, and from there you will be able to watch on-demand content or the broadcast if it's live

Will the content be available on demand after the event?

Yes. Content will be available on Salesforce+ the morning Dreamforce starts, as well as during and after Dreamforce for your viewing pleasure.

ACCESSIBILITY

What accessibility accommodations are available for the broadcast?

During the live broadcast, English captions will be available across all channels via a button in the lower-right corner. There will be American Sign Language (ASL) on the Primetime channel throughout the AMER broadcast.

How do I turn on/off closed captioning?

Click on the gear icon in the player controls and select "Live Captions" under Captions. When enabled, English captions will appear inside the video player. This can be used to toggle the English

captions on or off. If you're still experiencing an issue, please try refreshing your browser window.

LIVESTREAM TECHNICAL FAQ

I have logged in and registered but I am receiving the following error message: "The Video Player was not able to find valid authentication information. Please contact technical support."

This message is received because the session cookie for the video authentication is blocked while using Chrome. There are two features in Chrome that could block cookies.

Feature one: We recommend the following steps in Chrome to allow third-party cookies: (1) Go to Settings > Privacy and security. (2) Click on "Cookies and other site data." (3) Ensure "Block third-party cookies" is NOT selected. (4) Once the setting is changed, then either close the browser or clear the browser cache and try to load the video again.

Feature two: We recommend the following steps in Chrome for SameSite setting: (1) Go to chrome://flags/. (2) Search for "Cookies." (3) Ensure "SameSite by default cookies" is set to "disabled."

What should I do if I don't have any audio?

First, check that your computer has the sound turned on and the volume up by going to your computer's audio settings and pressing the test sounds, or navigating to another video on the web and making sure you can hear audio through your computer speakers or headphones.

If you hear audio on other videos on the web and not on the live video stream, check that the volume in the player is turned up.

How do I turn on/off closed captioning?

Click on the gear icon in the player controls and select "English" under Captions. When enabled, captions will appear inside the video player. This can be used to toggle the captions on or off. If you're still experiencing an issue, please try refreshing your browser window.

I don't have a video. What should I do?

Try watching at a lower quality by hovering over the player and clicking on the text that says Best, 720, 480, 360, or 240. Start with the lowest bit rate and work your way up so the stream plays back smoothly.

I can only see the "coming soon" slide. Should the slide be advancing?

Check your internet connection by running a speed test (<u>speedtest.net</u>) to determine your download speed. To view a 720/HD stream, you will need download speeds at around 1.5–2 mbps. You can

I'm getting an IBM error. What should I do?

What if I can only see the Q&A window?

What are our options if we are running into additional firewall issues?

Dreamforce content, both live and on demand, will be available on Salesforce+, which will be hosted on salesforce.com (as opposed to being a subdomain like trailhead.salesforce.com). So if your customers are able to access salesforce.com, they should be able to access Dreamforce content. If there are any issues, we'd recommend trying off/on vpn or off/on incognito.

- 6. Code must be redeemed by October 31, 2021, at 11:59 p.m. PT.

What about Dreamforce attendees who already have Disney+?
