On activating the Delete button in a component or form section on the Canvas focus is lost.

Focus jumps back to the component in the Canvas after adding, sorting or deleting Tabs in the Properties panel using the keyboard.

Focus jumps back to the component in the Canvas after adding or deleting Filters in the Properties panel using the keyboard.

Focus jumps back to the component in the Canvas after using any input in the component Properties panel using the keyboard, for example the field section component.

When the "Page" properties link in the breadcrumb list of the Properties panel is activated, visible focus is lost.

The keyboard focus order is not correctly provided for the information icons available for the "Classification Type" and "Update Action" combo boxes within the "Case - Service Console" flexi page editor.

In most LAB components and functions, the name, role, and value of user interface elements are available to assistive technologies via HTML or WAI-ARIA to describe the identity, operation, and state. However, there are exceptions:

- In a Quip document component, the Template URL field is grayed out as read only. When it is left blank and an error is shown, the error is not possible to associate with the text field in "forms mode" because the field is disabled and does not get keyboard focus.
- In the Create a new Lightning page modal, step 1, modal dialog, the user can choose the page type at left. They appear visually as a set of links but are <input type="radio"> nested within <a> tags. Some screen readers announce these as both links and radio buttons.
- For nested Components or Field Sections, for the inner component, the "Insert a component [before/after]" buttons are not announced properly by some screen readers. Only the name and position of the component is announced, not the button function or role of button.
- In the Properties panel for tab components, tabs can be renamed, sorted and deleted. When keyboard focus lands on one of these controls focus is on the and visibly outlining the whole rectangle. Screen readers are announcing the control plus the two controls within it and the pop information on the Delete button.
- In the New Filter modal, Advanced radio button screen, the Select button under Field has no label associated.
- On the Page Properties panel, there is a section for Data Providers that includes buttons for Edit and Delete. If these buttons are visually and functionally disabled, they lack any indication for screen readers that they are disabled.
- In the second step of the Create Ruleset process, the Delete buttons for each condition have no accessible name or label. They do have an aria-describedby that attaches pop up content, but that attribute does not provide an accessible name.
