

Revenue Cloud Billing Rate Card



A quantity of Billing Events is included with certain Salesforce Services, with the specific entitlement indicated on the Usage Details table on the Order Form for such Services. Billing Events must be used before the Order End Date set forth in the Usage Details table on the Order Form, and no rollover will be permitted. Customer consumes these Billing Events at the applicable multiplier rate based on the Usage Type identified below.

Usage Type	Unit	Multiplier
Invoicing*	Per \$1 USD (or portion thereof) of Total Invoice Amount	0.02

Usage types and associated multipliers may be updated from time to time.

* **Invoicing** - One (1) Billing Event will be consumed for each \$50 USD of Total Invoice Amount and any portion thereof at the multiplier rate set forth in the table below. Total Invoice Amount means the sum total of all Subtotals for Invoices posted during the Order Term. For purposes of the foregoing, "Invoice" means an invoice posted by the Customer through the Services and "Subtotal" means the total value of goods or services, together with shipping and handling charges, reflected on an Invoice, but excluding taxes. To the extent the Subtotal is denominated in a currency other than USD, the Subtotal will be converted into USD by applying the average exchange rate for the relevant day, as provided by Salesforce's then-current exchange rate provider.
